



Supplementary Figure 1. Liver biopsy findings: a) **Patient ID 1:** Predominant lobular hepatitis with diffuse spotty (single cell) necrosis and numerous (micro)granuloma; b) **Patient ID 2:** Macrovesicular steatosis (40% large droplet) with portal fibrosis, spotty (single cell) necrosis and few ceroid laden macrophages; c) **Patient ID 5:** Acute to subacute hepatitis with confluent necrosis predominate in zone 3 (10 % of parenchyma) associated with lobular collapse. No fibrosis; d) **Patient ID 9:** Macrovesicular steatosis (15-20%, large droplet) with portal and lobular inflammation and portal and pericentral fibrosis. Few hepatocytes with ballooning degeneration and Mallory hyaline.
